

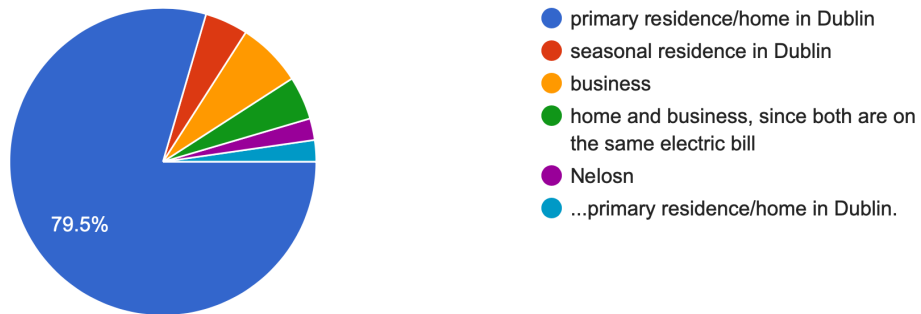

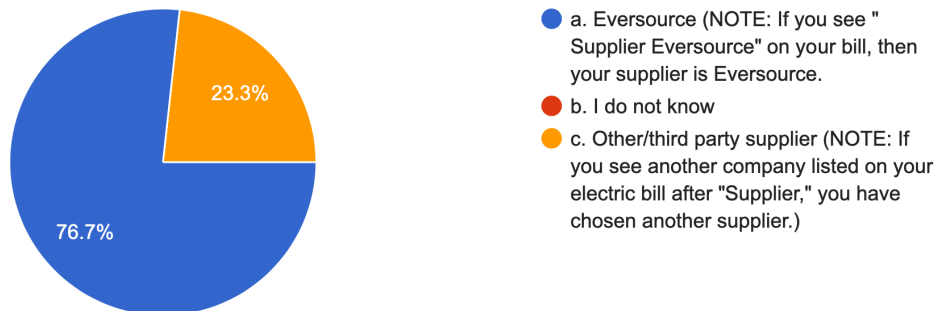

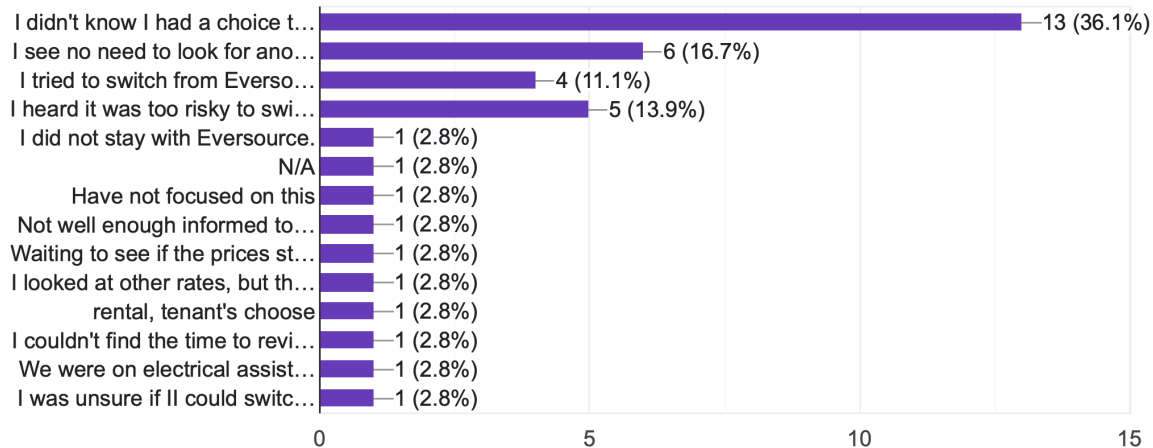
2. Who is your electricity supplier ... (Choose just one below)

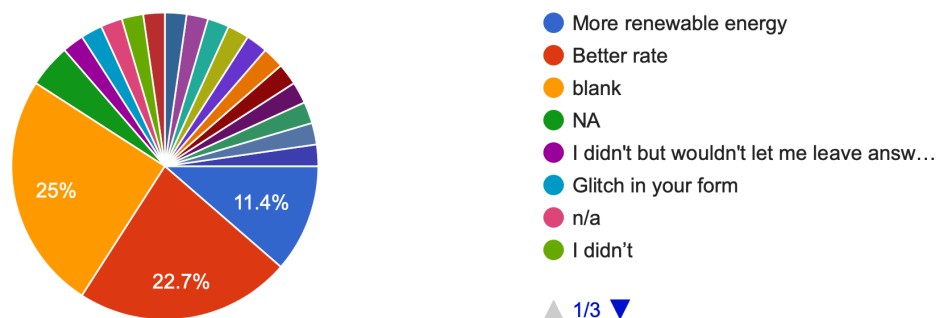
3. If you choose "a." above (Eversource), why did you stay with Eversource? (Select all that apply, and skip question 4). If you did not choose "a." go to question 4.

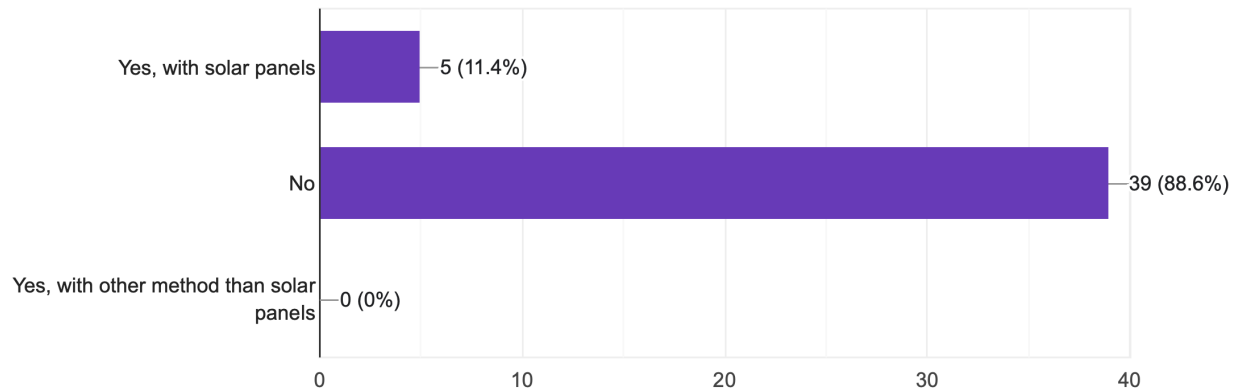

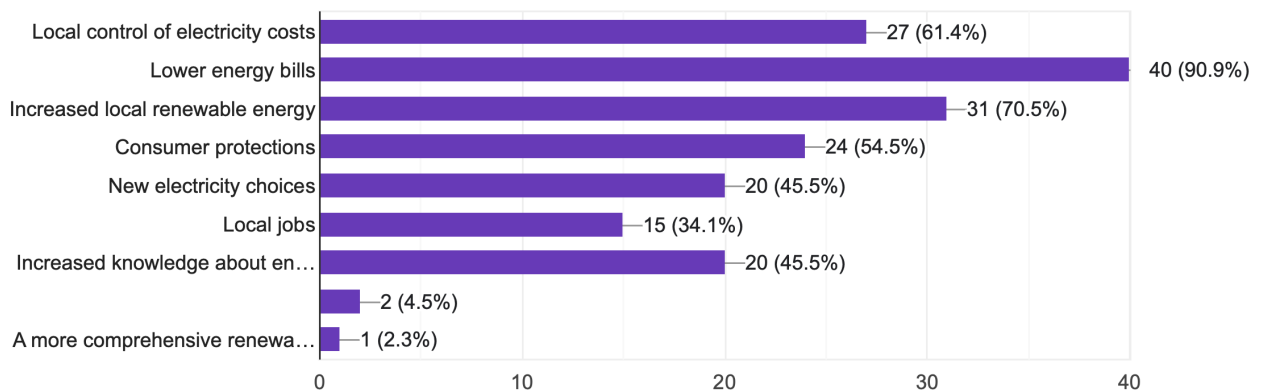
5. Do you generate your own electricity onsite with solar panels or another method? Check all that apply.

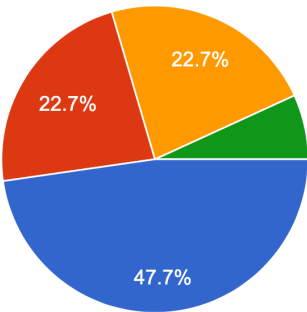

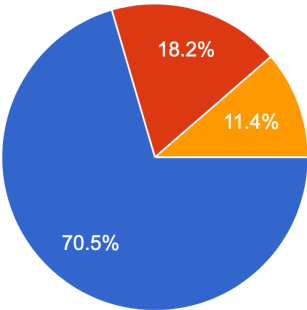

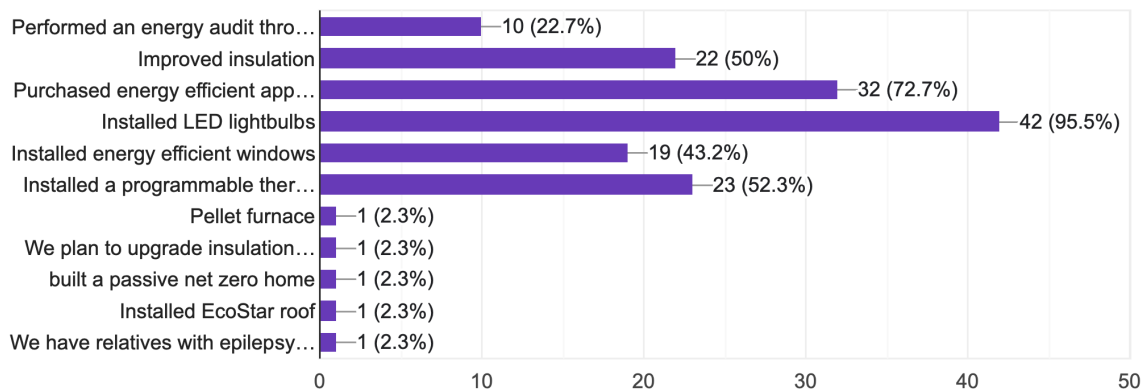

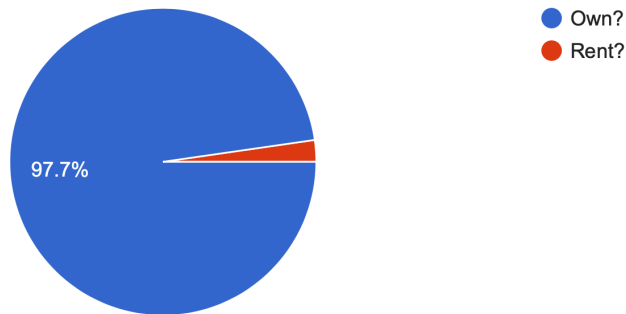

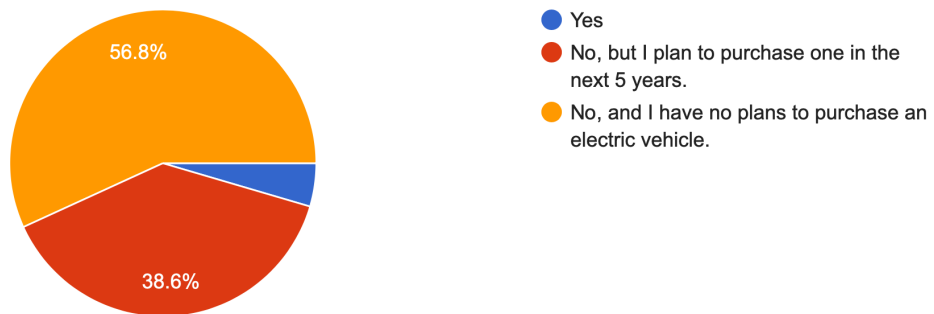

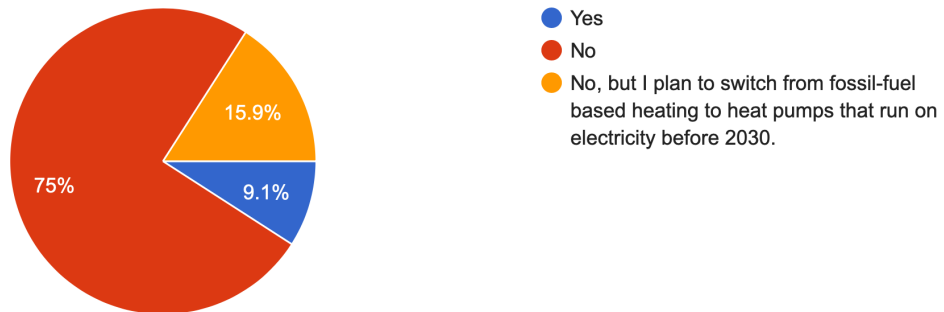

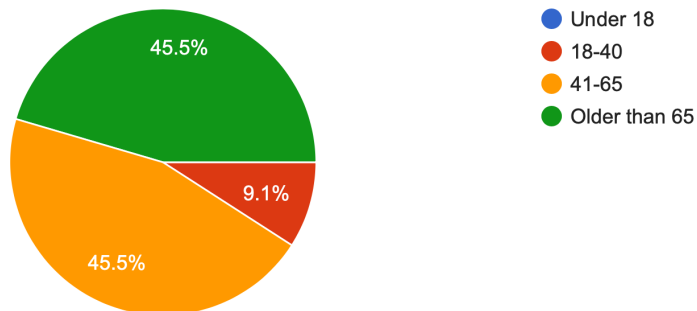
13. Do you heat your home or business with electric heat pumps? (Make one choice).
