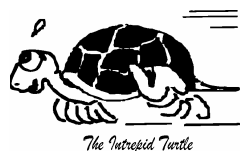


Eighth Annual Terry Dwyer Memorial Dublin 5K

Directions:

From points West, Interstate 91 and Brattleborough, VT: Head to Keene, NH then follow Route 101 East (16 miles to Dublin, NH). Monument Road is 0.5 miles on the left beyond the flagpole in the center of Town.

From points East, Nashua and Interstate 93: Head to Peterborough, NH, then follow Route 101 West (5 miles to Dublin, NH). Monument Road is 1.5 miles on the right past the blinking light at the Route 137 intersection.

From North or South: Follow routes 202 or 137 to intersection with Route 101. Follow Route 101 West. Monument Road is 1.5 miles on the right past the blinking light at the Route 101/137 intersection.
