

Conservation Commission Draft Minutes
6/15/22

Conservation Commission Chair Jay Schechter called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. Present were Maria Finnegan, Katy Wardlaw, Jerry Branch and June Brening.

- Finance – April: General Fund \$ 5,755.00, Land Acquisition Fund \$69,500.00.
- Publicity - Articles for Dublin Advocate – Jay & Jerry submitted articles about Invasives & Cleanup at the Park for the July edition of the Advocate.
- Rotary Park – Jerry - Budget for the remainder of the year will be spent on continuing the road into the park. Jerry will coordinate this work with Sturdy Thomas of Good Digs and the Dublin Road Department.
- Water & Wetlands Subcommittee - Jay will ask Felicity about procuring a speaker from NH Lakes. If we want to proceed with conducting a community event we will have to decide on a venue.
- Taking Action for Wildlife - Katy Wardlaw - Taking Action for Wildlife is a collaboration between NH Fish and Game and UNH Cooperative Extension to assist communities and landowners in conserving wildlife and habitats in New Hampshire. The 2022 Community Conservation Cohort is taking applications now from Conservation Commissions throughout the state to participate in an intensive on-line training program and community project in September and October. Katy to find out the number of days involved and on which days of the week the on-line sessions will take place.
- Invasives - Jay - Assembling a list of properties to be treated. Currently has 10-12 locations on list and can do about 15 in one day. The spraying will be done by Vegetative Control Services. Jay to meet with Susie Macy, from the Garden Club of Dublin, at the post office to determine which areas to treat.
