Dale called the hearing to order at 4:00 p.m.

Dale read the public notice that was posted for this hearing:

“The Dublin Board of Selectmen, in accordance with RSA 31:95-d will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at 4:00 pm at the Town Hall, 1120 Main Street to discuss the petition warrant article submitted to rescind the Recycling Special Revenue Fund”.

Dale asked for any comments. Tom Kennedy stated that he did not think it was a good idea to rescind the fund, as it has been used in the past to purchase things for the Transfer Station. Dale stated that if the fund was closed we would likely need to establish a Capital Reserve account next year. Dale also stated that if the Selectmen felt there was too much money in the Recycling Fund they might be able to create an article to take some out and put towards fund balance. Dale stated that the Selectmen feel that it is important to have money available to purchase equipment or to use if the plan to redesign the Transfer Station moves forward in the future.

There being no further business, on a motion by Walter, the hearing was adjourned at 4:12 p.m.
