CALL TO ORDER: Chris Raymond called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM

SELECTMANS BUSINESS:

1. Conservation Commission-Rotary Park-

- RSA 36-A was reviewed in response to the question of why the Select Board representative is not a voting member of the Conservation Commission. According to the RSA members are appointed and could have the ability to vote. The Board has reviewed the RSA and agreed that the Select Board representative should remain a non-voting member; this could be reconsidered in March when the term starts.
- A raft is being stored on Town property. Carole shared that this topic had been discussed and that the Reservoir is being emptied and the owner allows the public to use the raft so it is a public benefit. Discussion ensued and the Board and Conservation Commission agree that the deed will be researched. Hunting in the park was discussed and a question arose about posting.
- 2. **Budget Discussion**-The new Cost of Living Adjustment rates were discussed and the last three years of pay rates were reviewed. A spreadsheet with the payroll implications of the COLA at different percentages will be created.
- 3. Timber Tax warrant-signed by Board

- 4. **Doomage Abatement**-Discussion ensued about abating Doomage charges for three 2020 timber cuts Map 7 Lot 4, Map 8 Lot 50-3 and Map 7 Lot 6; the abatement was denied.
