The Board would like Tom to get an estimate from Mike Richardson, as the repair could be done at the Highway Garage which would save us the transportation fee. Tom said he will need to rent a forklift from someone. Dale was aware and if Mike can do the work for less than what WD Matthews is estimating, then we can just rent the forklift from them. Dale moved to have Tom proceed with emergency repair with WD Matthews if we don't get a response from Mike by tomorrow morning. Walter seconded. Vote 3-0<sup>-1</sup>
